

Environmental Policy Statement

This Policy Statement outlines our endorsement and approach to environmental management within mclcreate and intends to communicate to all personnel, the overall aim of our Environmental Management System. At mclcreate we regard environmental issues to be especially important and we shall aim to limit the environmental impact which our business has, wherever feasibly possible.

The Company's scope of operation is the hire, installation and operation of video, audio visual and sound equipment and the project management of exhibitions, shows and conferences. Within the constraints of this scope it is the Policy of the organisation to:

- Not cause or knowingly permit pollution and to seek to improve the environmental performance of the Company continuously.
- Foster the commitment of all management and staff to continually improve the environmental performance of the business.
- Train all staff in the company's policies, procedures, objectives and targets as appropriate.
- Monitor and comply with all relevant governmental, local authority and other appropriate legislative and regulatory environmental requirements.
- Review environmental objectives and targets set by the Company during regular management review meetings as part of our planned framework for improvement.
- Aim to minimise the use of all materials, supplies and energy.
- Wherever practicable the Company will use recyclable materials and components.
- Encourage similar environmental standards of our own from all major third parties involved with our business.
- Achieve requirements by working in accordance with ISO 14001:2015 Environmental Management Systems.

We have prepared this statement as our commitment to environmental management at mclcreate. This message shall be communicated and understood throughout the company and we expect that all persons carrying out work upon behalf of mclcreate, share these values.

This policy statement shall be made available to the public, upon request and subject to annual review to ensure its continued suitability.
